Guidelines on How to Access CNA International Policies on CNA Central

CNA ComPass™ provides agents and brokers with access to their CNA International policies on CNA Central. For assistance, use these [access instructions](#), which include screenshots, or follow the easy steps below:

1. Log into CNA Central using your CNA Central ID at www.cnacentral.com.
2. In the left navigation bar, click on "Service My Accounts" and then "Electronic Document Delivery."
3. In the Electronic Document Delivery section complete the fields for "Branch Code" and "Producer Code."

Note: You will need to refer to the specific Premium Invoice you received for the WorldPass® policy for the two codes. They are located at the top of the right hand side of the invoice appearing as numbers ending with a unique identifier – 884 - Example: (xxxxxx-884)
4. The next screen will populate all policies that have been uploaded under the unique Branch/Producer code selected.
 - This screen enables filtering capabilities, allowing you to search based on: Policy Number, Customer Name and Effective As Of. (When searching by Policy Number do not include the WP or PST prefixes. Use just the numbers in the policy number.)
 - If documents are available, you will see them on this screen with a "View Document" link to the right of each document.
